Saint William of York

Bishop & Confessor † 1154 Feast: 8th June

The election of the humble treasurer of York Minster as Archbishop in 1141 caused political unrest among the canons and the Cistercians. Some went as far as accusing him of simony. Cleared of the charges and consecrated in 1141, he was deposed by the Pope Eugenius III in 1147 and replaced with a Cistercian abbot. So upset were the people of York that they barred his successor's entry into the city. Submitting humbly, William retired to an austere monastic life in Winchester. After Pope Anastasius IV restored him to his See in 1153, thousands flocked to welcome him back to York, causing Ouse Bridge to collapse, miraculously without casualties. He died just a month later. His incorrupt body and many miracles led to his canonisation in 1226.
